REVIEW OF SERVICE PROVIDER FEES

SUBJECT: AIMS Workers' Compensation Claims Administration Services

BACKGROUND AND STATUS:

At their meeting on August 21, 2008, the Administration and Financial Services Subcommittee discussed AIMS' Workers' Compensation Claims Administration Service fees as well as the fees for the Allied Managed Care (AMC) bill review services, which are part of the claims administration contract.

The Subcommittee requested that AIMS provide options for reductions of the bill review fees and to provide a cap on fees for all areas including Standard Official Medical Fee Schedules (OMFS), Preferred Provider Organizations (PPOs), and Negotiated Hospital/Surgical bill audits. In addition, at the request of the Subcommittee, AIMS will provide the Subcommittee with the number of Full Time Equivalent (FTE) employees working on bill review for the CSJVRMA account.
