STRUCTURED RETURN-TO-WORK PROGRAM

SUBJECT: Discussion of the Proposed Structured Return-to-Work Program

BACKGROUND AND STATUS:

At the January 14, 2009, Workers' Compensation Subcommittee meeting, Bickmore Risk Services (BRS) and Acclamation Insurance Management Services (AIMS) presented the proposed Structured Return-to-Work Program. Discussion ensued and the Subcommittee requested a follow-up meeting to allow time for the Subcommittee members to review the program in greater depth prior to making a decision as to its implementation..

As services for this program would be provided by both AIMS and BRS, the Subcommittee requested details of how CSJVRMA's contracts with the two parties would be structured. Contract details will be provided at the meeting.
