### Confined Space Entry / Non-Entry Rescue

This program is intended for those managing, supporting or working in confined spaces. The program covers regulations and hazards regarding confined space operations, providing participants with information for developing compliant and safe entry operations. Topics covered include equipment requirements, personnel and training requirements, program requirements and non-entry rescue options.

#### Who should attend?

- **Maintenance personnel:** These are personnel who may enter permit-required confined spaces.

## Police Pursuit Immunity

---

One of the essential functions of law enforcement is to pursue and apprehend criminals. Unfortunately, vehicle pursuits are inherently dangerous, and public entities can end up bearing the burden of expensive lawsuits related to death or injuries caused by vehicle pursuits. In an effort to promote safe vehicle pursuits, the Legislature enacted Vehicle Code section 17004.7, which provides public agencies with immunity if the agency adopts, promulgates and trains on an appropriate vehicle pursuit policy. This presentation will detail and discuss how public agencies can ensure and establish compliance with the procedural requirements of the Vehicle Pursuit Immunity, such as the requirements of the vehicle pursuit policy, how to promulgate the policy and how to train on the policy. The session will also discuss how to maintain records and assist legal counsel in preparation of motions to establish the immunity defense before trial. Classes will be held in person 9:00-10:30.
